By letting them know ahead of time, they may be a little more patient and give you the time that you need. We realize that all of these questions may not apply to your own situation and therefore we encourage you to ask questions that apply to your child's needs.

- Do you currently serve any individuals with physical or cognitive disabilities that you know of at this time?
- What is your teacher to student ratio for classes and/or activities offered?
- How is your staff trained on providing services for individuals with disabilities?
- Can you provide the additional support my child needs i.e. toileting, feeding? (Feel free to share examples of any specific assistance needed.)
