 Understand the rights of consumers and families as candidates for, and participants in, the Self-Determination Program

Eligibility

Participation in the Self-Determination Program is available to people who:

- Are regional center consumers
- Agree to the following specified in the law:
 - ➤ Orientation
 - Use Self-Determination Program funds only when generic services are not available
 - Only purchase services necessary to implement the Individual Program Plan
 - Manage services and supports within an individual budget
 - Use a Financial Management Services provider

Leaving the Program

- Someone can voluntarily choose to leave the Self-Determination Program at any time
- Regional centers must ensure that there is no gap in delivery of services and supports

What if someone moves?

- Participants can continue to receive selfdetermination services and supports if he or she transfers to another regional center
- The balance of the individual budget follows them to their new regional center
