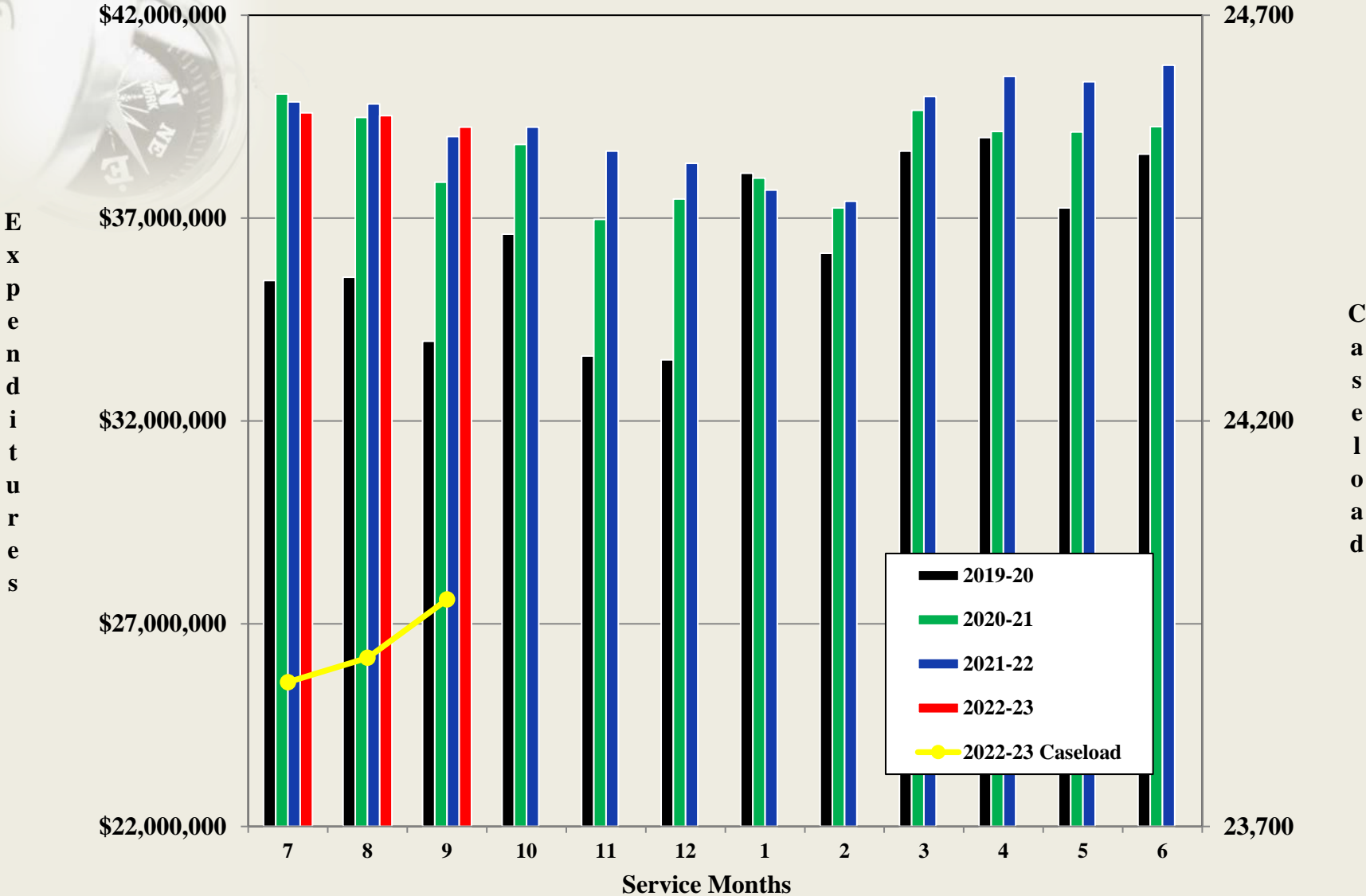


Recent Protests and Concerns

RCOC News

- **Vendors' staffing shortages continue**
 - **Westview, which was one of RCOC's largest day program vendors pre-pandemic, will discontinue its day programs and provide only tailored-day services when Alternative Services end on December 31, 2022. Westview serves 290 individuals. We do not know how many persons Westview will serve under tailored-day services.**
 - **Received WIC §4731 complaints (alleged rights violation) from parents whose children are not receiving their authorized services because vendors cannot staff the hours.**

RCOC News

- **637 proposal – asking DDS to waive regulations and allow RCOC to fund social recreation, camp and non-medical therapy services directly through a Financial Management Service (FMS) without requiring parents to go through the vendorization process for reimbursement when paid out of pocket**
