Inclusive education is not a watered-down approach to special education but a realization of the research and policy that states that children with mild to severe disabilities should “have access to the general education curriculum in the regular classroom, to the maximum extent possible” (IDEA).

Implementation strategies will be shared with examples for differentiated teaching, universal design, and standards-based IEPs. We will discuss the importance of inclusive education and its impact on long-term successful outcomes. Lastly, we will share how one school district implemented inclusive education in Orange County.
