Dr. Junie Lazo-Pearson, BCBA-D is dedicated to providing quality ABA services to children and adults with autism and other developmental disabilities. She is able to do this through her work with Advanced Behavioral Health, Inc., a private practice that provides behavioral health treatment in California. Dr. Lazo-Pearson received her Ph.D. in Developmental and Child Psychology specializing in applied behavior analysis from the University of Kansas. At the University of Kansas, she worked with children diagnosed with Emotional Behavior Disorder/Severe Emotional Disturbance using functional assessments, and designing and implementing behavioral programs in general education settings. In the past, Dr. Lazo-Pearson was selected to Chair the Insurance Workgroup as part of the Orange County Autism Task Force under the Senate Select Committee for Autism Spectrum Disorders. Dr. Lazo-Pearson has been invited and presented to regional and national conferences and organizations. Dr. Lazo-Pearson continues to work towards assisting individuals with developmental disabilities maximize their potential and live in the least restrictive environment.
