The START model is an evidence-informed model of integrated community crisis prevention & intervention services for individuals ages 6 and older with intellectual and developmental disabilities and mental health needs. The START model is designed to develop community capacity while achieving wellbeing for those served. The START model uses multiple evidence-based practices, including person-centered, culturally competent, whole person, solution-focused, systemic, positive psychology, and other practice.
